the first step: know your shoe size.

After all, if your feet aren't happy,
you're not happy.

Measure yourself. Not sure how? Read on.

- Place a piece of blank paper on a hard floor, and stand on the paper in stocking feet.
- Place one mark at the edge of your heel, and another at the tip of your longest toe.
- Step off and measure between the two marks. Measure your other foot in the same way.
- If you're between sizes or have one foot larger than the other, choose the larger size.

Measurements for boots and heels:

- You'll want to measure around the fullest part of your calf with a measuring tape. When shopping for boots, you'll see this referred to as the "shaft circumference".
- Measure starting at the bottom of your heel, then running straight up the back of your calf. You'll see this referred to as the "shaft height" when you look at a boot's detailed information.
- We measure heel height from the floor to the point where the heel meets the sole of the shoe. You'll see heel heights in the following ranges:

Low (1–1½")

Mid (2–2½")

High (3–3½")

Ultra-high (4" or taller)
