

GOOD CANDY BAD CANDY BAG



1. Gather your supplies: a metal pail or bucket, a paintbrush or sponge paintbrush, chalkboard paint, chalk markers, scissors, regular chalk and black foam core.



2. Paint the outside of the metal pail completely with chalkboard paint.



8. Allow it to dry completely.



4. Using the chalk markers, begin designing your pail.



5. One side should be labeled "good" along with a kooky design, like a smiley jack-o'-lantern. The other should be labeled "bad" along with an opposing design, like a grimacing jack-o'-lantern.



6. To create the divider, measure the diameter of the top of the pail, the diameter of the bottom of the pail, and the height of the pail. Then, draw out a piece on the black foam core that fits these measurements and cut it out.



7. Insert the divider into the pail.



8. Prepare to get out there and start collecting candy! Halloween will never be the same again now that you can sort your candy while you go door to door.
