



MENU IN A BOTTLE



1. Gather your supplies: a green or blue glass bottle, green glitter spray paint, gold spray paint, coffee, assorted seashells, a poly-mesh bag, sandpaper, super glue with gel control, a pen and white construction paper.



2. Using a piece of sandpaper, scratch the entire bottle. This will make it easier for the spray paint and seashells to stick to the bottle.



3. Place the bottle into the poly-mesh bag entirely and prepare a surface outside to spray paint the bottle.



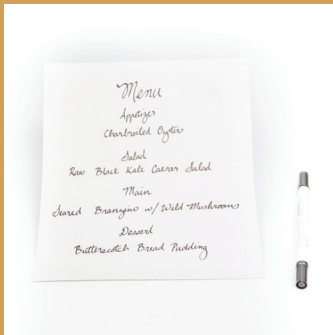
4. Holding the top of the bottle inside the poly-mesh bag tightly, roll the bottle gently at an angle while you spray paint the bottle. Make sure to keep the bottle moving. Allow this layer to dry completely before moving onto the next step.



5. Repeat the step 4 with the green glitter spray paint. Allow it to dry completely.



6. Using super glue, add "barnacles" of assorted seashells to your bottle.



7. While the bottle is drying, write your menu onto the white construction paper.



8. Prepare the coffee, then crumple the paper menu and submerge it completely into the coffee.



9. Allow it to soak for five minutes or until the paper assumes a desired shade of brown. Let the excess coffee drip off the paper into the sink, then hang the menu to dry completely.



10. Roll up the menu and place it into the opening at the top of your shipwrecked bottle – leave a bit of the menu sticking out at the top. Repeat steps 2 through 9 until you have one bottle and one menu for each of your guests.



11. Set the table along with your shipwrecked bottles and menus and prepare to enjoy a Halloween-themed meal that has risen up from the depths! #HalloweenHills
