

SPIDER BITES



1. Gather your ingredients: orange chocolate chips, regular chocolate chips, pretzel sticks, vegetable oil, maraschino cherries, orange sprinkles, brown sprinkles, dark chocolate frosting, brownie mix, eggs and red icing.



2. For this project, you will also need an egg tray, a cake pop tray and parchment paper.



3. Mix the brownie batter according to the directions on the package.



4. Scoop half of the brownie batter into the egg trays, only filling each hole half way. Place the tray in the oven and cook as long as directed on the package.



5. Scoop the remaining brownie batter into the cake pop tray, filling the holes to the top. Once filled, place a maraschino cherry in the center of each. Place the tray in the oven and cook as long as directed on the package.



6. Remove the trays from the oven, and flip them onto a cooling tray. Allow to cool completely.



7. Once they've cooled, frost the tops of each of the brownies using the dark chocolate frosting.



8. Place the regular chocolate chips in a bowl, then microwave for a minute – stirring occasionally – until they have completely melted. Then, dip the pretzel sticks 3/4 of the way into the melted chocolate and place







9. Melt the orange chocolate chips the same way, then use a spoon to drizzle stripes onto each of the pretzel sticks. Allow them to dry completely.



11. Poke eight pretzel sticks into the back of the spider to create the legs. For more realistic looking appendages, bond two pretzel sticks together using the dark chocolate frosting. Attach two antennae to the front of the spider using the same technique.



them on parchment paper to dry.

10. Using the dark chocolate frosting like adhesive, scoop a small amount onto the back of the cake pop brownie and the front of the egg-shaped brownie. Stick them together. Then, sprinkle a layer of chocolate sprinkles, and a layer of orange sprinkles on top of this.

12. Using the red tube of icing, make two dots on the front of the spider for eyes.



13. Plate your spiders on a tray, and make sure you eat them before they crawl away! #HalloweenHills
