

STORY BOOK NIGHTLIGHT



1. Gather your supplies: a candy jar, paintbrushes, black acrylic paint, an X-Acto knife, orange tissue paper, construction paper, a drinking glass, spray adhesive, scissors, tape, felt, LED tea light candles and a bottle cork.



2. Tape off a square window on the candy jar.



3. Paint the cork and candy jar with black acrylic paint, except for the square space you have taped off. Set aside to dry.



4. Line the bottom of the candy jar with a square piece of black felt.



5. Draw silhouette images onto black construction paper for the scenes that will wrap around your storybook nightlight. Then, use an X-Acto knife to cut out images.



6. Measure a piece of tissue paper to wrap around the drinking glass and cut the piece out with an X-Acto knife.



7. Use spray adhesive to glue the tissue paper to the glass, making sure to wrap the tissue paper around the top and bottom edges. Then, make sure the glass is upside down, and use the spray adhesive to glue the silhouette pieces to the



8. Turn the glass right side up (the silhouettes should now be upside down). Then, turn on the LED tea light candles and place them in the drinking glass with the lights pointing down.



tissue paper.





9. Place the candy jar over the glass as it is.



10. Then, flip the entire thing over, making sure to hold the glasses together as you turn the nightlight right side up.



11. Measure a circular piece of felt for the top of the glass that now rests inside the nightlight. Attach the felt to the glass, then attach the bottle cork to the felt. Allow to fully dry.



12. Slowly spin the smaller glass inside the candy jar to reveal the stories that surround the glass. Use the storybook nightlight to inspire even more spooky and silly Halloween stories. #HalloweenHills
