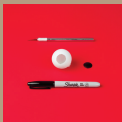




THREE-EYED MONSTER HEADBAND



1. Gather your supplies: a sweatband, cotton balls, pipe cleaners, a strip of faux fur, three ping-pong balls, a black marker, an X-Acto knife, needle and thread, felt, scissors and a pencil.



2. With a pencil, draw a small circle onto the center of your ping-pong balls. Cut the small circles out using an X-Acto knife. Then, using a black marker, entirely color in the centers you've cut out.



3. Flip the ping-pong balls over so the hole is not showing. Then, sew the black pupil onto the ping-pong ball. Make sure you use a thimble when you do this step, or use an X-Acto knife to make a tiny hole on the ping-pong ball first, then thread the pupil through.



4. Draw a horn shape onto a piece of felt, then cut it out. Repeat this three more times.



5. Sew two horn shapes together along three of the edges.



6. Stuff the horn with shredded cotton balls. Then, repeat these steps to make the other horn, too.



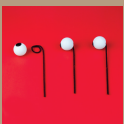
7. Sew the last remaining side closed on both horns.



8. Place the sweatband on your head, then wrap the strip of faux fur around it. Place two fingers on the ends of the faux fur and hold both the fur and sweatband together. Keeping a tight hold and your fingers in place, remove them both from your head. Sew the faux fur to the sweatband securely only at the two ends of the fabric. The faux fur fabric should hang loosely around the sweatband so that it's not too tight when you put the headband on again.



9. Sew the two felt horns onto the headband.



10. Create a loop at the end of the pipe cleaners, then insert the loop into the hole in the back of the ping-pong ball eyes.



11. Loop the other end of the pipe cleaners around the sweatband until they're secure. They should rest in between the sweatband and the piece of faux fur.



12. Put on your new monster headband and prepare to see with new (three to be exact) eyes! #HalloweenHills
